7. Describe a weekly format for your meeting? What day? What time? How long? Where to meet? How to start? How to finish?
8. What would cause you to not enjoy this meeting?
9. Compare/contrast and then discuss these phrases:
 - a. "Men standing back to back for one another against all comers"
 - b. "Men holding each other accountable"
10. Does one sound or "feel" better to you? Which one? Why?
11. Define Christ as "Master".
12. Define camaraderie.
13. Define brotherhood.
14. Define encouragement.
15. If you have blown it privately—in purity, anger management, financially, as a parent—whatever— how do you want to communicated with?
